ABOUT THE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN:

For our first phase, we are raising an estimated \$2.1 million for a 13,400-square-foot school building, which includes 7 classrooms, two therapy rooms, administrative offices, a lobby and reception area, a kitchen, and a lunchroom. For Phase II, we will build a multipurpose activities building. And for Phase III, we will add seven more classrooms and expand our lunchroom. Our total campaign is expected to be about \$4.0 million.
